## 100 Years Ago

From the Galena Daily Gazette, February 9, 1909

### Special Lincoln Postage Stamp

Memorial Issue Will Be on Sale in Galena on Feb. 12. Several hundred of the special Lincoln issue of postage stamps have been received at the Galena office, and will be placed on sale on Friday of this week. The issue was made possible through a recent act of congress providing for a Lincoln memorial issue which should be placed on sale in the various offices through out the United States Lincoln's birthday, February 12th. The stamps are printed in red with a side view of the great emancipator in the center, and at the bottom the inscription 1809-Feb. 12-1909. They will doubtless be eagerly sought after by local stamp collectors.

Look for the Abraham Lincoln display of Memorabilia in the Historical Collections Room as well as in the hallway across from the Historical Collections Room and throughout the Library.
